Features: Municipal clean runoff rain garden, ponding depression, rock mulch swale, native plants

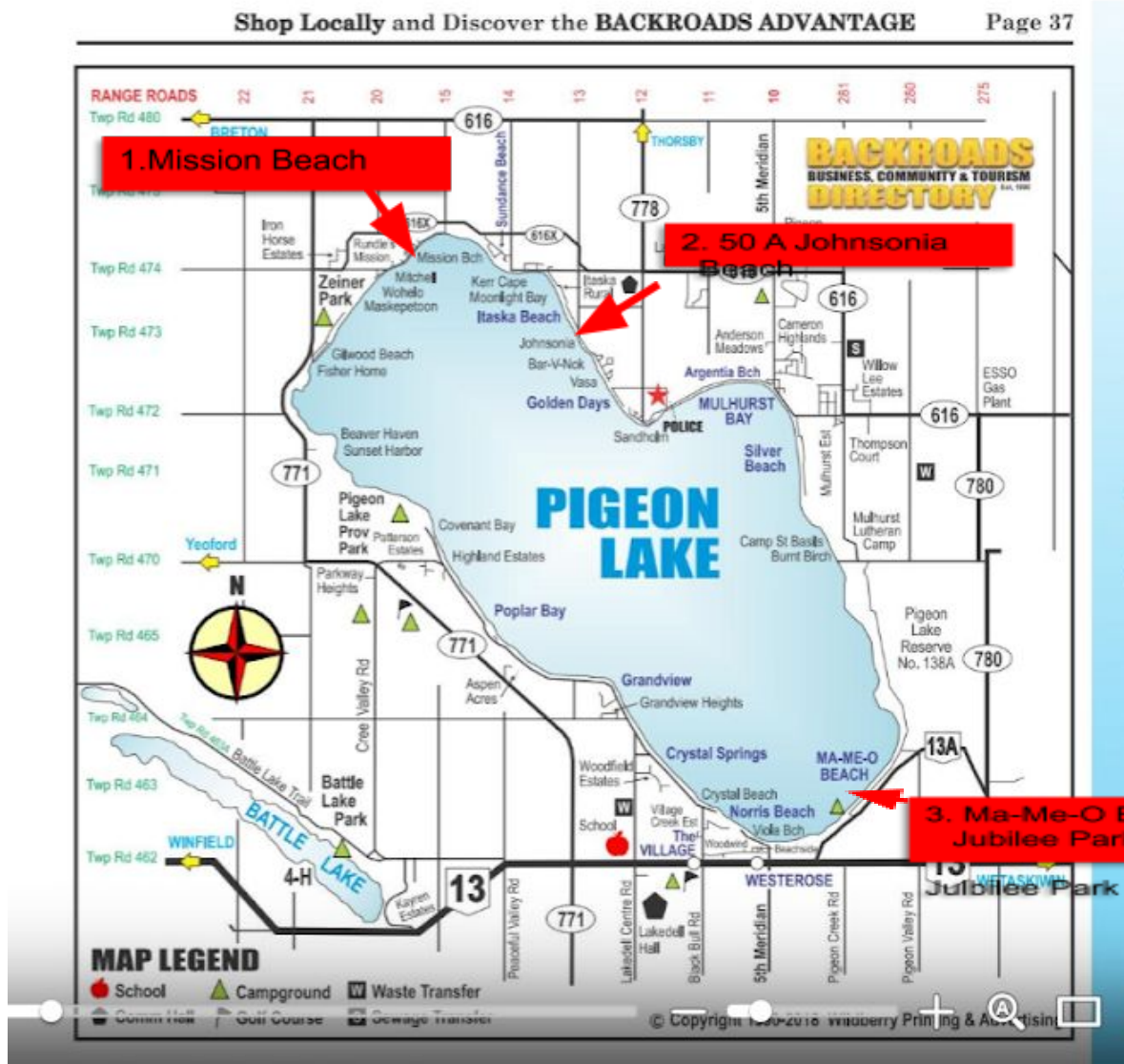
